9:23-9:30	Arrival & Greeting/Question of the Day  Mrs. Winters will retrieve the children from the bus and before care. Mrs. Stolte will gather parent drop-offs outside, take a headcount, walk to the classroom, hang up belongings, answer the Question of the Day and wash hands before morning snack.
9:30-9:45	Morning Snack / Bathroom Reminders Children will have their parent provided snack or free breakfast as appropriate. Children will eat, clean up, and wash hands before signing in at the writing table.
9:45-9:55*	Transition: Daily Sign In / Attendance Chart Children will practice writing their names at the writing table and move their name from home to school on the attendance chart before engaging with fine motor manipulatives on the rug until Morning Meeting.
9:55-10:10	Morning Meeting (Large Group) <u>Home/School Chart</u> : Attendance count & compare more/fewer, <u>Job Chart</u> : check job <u>Greeting</u> : "Hello Neighbor", Flag Salute, Morning Messages
10:10-11:15	Planning /Choice Time  Students will plan their ideas for choice time and engage in play in the following areas:  Dramatic Play, Blocks, Discovery, Writing, Toys and Games, Art, Library, Cozy, Sand/Water & Music  Clean up time 11:10-11:15
11:15-11:30	Read-Aloud Sing "Author/Illustrator" song, Read story & engage children with comments, questions, acting it out
11:30-11:45	Small Group Time Children will engage in activities that focus on teaching specific skills. (Math, Literacy)
11:45-12:15	Outside Time Children will engage in gross motor activities that stimulate 7-9 different skills outdoors or indoors
12:20-12:50	Lunch / Bathroom Reminders Children will wash hands, manage their own lunch or receive school lunch, and clean-up, then use the bathroom and wash hands before rest time begins.
12:50-1:50	Rest Time Children will lay on their cots and relax their bodies as quiet music is played to practice self-regulation. Children who do not nap will be offered quiet activities for the remainder of rest time.
1:50-2:20	Limited Choice Time  Students will choose a place to play for a short time as cots are cleaned up from rest time.  Writing, Toys and Games, Art, Library, Cozy  Clean up time 2:10-2:20
2:25-2:50	Outside Time Children will engage in gross motor activities that stimulate 7-9 different skills outdoors or indoors
2:55-3:10	Afternoon Snack / Bathroom Reminders Children will wash hands, eat their snacks, clean up, wash hands, and pack up for dismissal.
3:10-3:15	Music and Movement Children will learn seasonal, monthly, and/or study related songs. Children will dance to get some wiggles out before transitioning to choice time.
3:15-3:20	Large Group Round-up / Goodbye Song Children will be able to recall their favorite part of the day and discuss any reminders for the next daySong: Skid-a-ma-rink
3:23-3:30	<b>Dismissal</b> Mrs. Stolte will dismiss the parent pick-ups at the green square, Mrs. Winters will dismiss the bussers and aftercare students.
