Goal of P.L.A.N.

To offer a <u>flexible</u> program whereby Barnegat High School students can complete <u>freshman year</u> of college prior to high school graduation.

- Program completion: At least 24 credits completed through OCC prior to HS graduation
- Classes can be achieved through multiple methods:
- Method 1: Early College classes (formerly Jump Start) at OCC's Southern Education Center;
- Method 2: Early College at Barnegat High School
- Method 3: Mix and Match (Combination of 1 & 2)



P.L.A.N. Requirements

- Early College at Barnegat High School
- Early College at Ocean County College
 - Both options require:
 - Barnegat HS Counseling Dept. approval
 - Ocean application via <u>www.ocean.edu</u>
 - Registration form with parent/guardian approval



P.L.A.N. Advantages

- Access to collegiate support and advising
- A jump start to post-secondary education
- Exposure to the collegiate experience
 - Research on dual enrollment suggests that students who enroll are more academically successful when they transfer schools, have an easier transition from HS to college, are less likely to need remediation, and save time & money in earning their degrees*
- Cost savings: \$105/credit (OCC Early College tuition)
- Flexible Class Schedules

Can I take any class I want to?

Early College students are held to the same standards as regular degree seeking Ocean County College students. Students should meet all college pre-requisite and readiness standards (<u>Policy 5165</u>) and have permission of their school counselors and parents prior to registration.

Effective Fall 2020 the tuition rate for Early College Courses is \$105.00 per credit, which includes the Board of Trustees scholarship awarded to high school students taking OCC courses.

Additional fees may apply for Early College at OCC and online courses.

Early College students are not eligible for Financial Aid as high school graduation or equivalent is a requirement of FAFSA completion.


