
Student Assistance Coordinator (SAC)

- Support all students; focus on substance use and social/emotional support
 - Meet with students 1:1 and small group settings
 - Support school counselors and staff with student referrals
 - Provide counseling referral services for students
 - Mentoring Program, Therapy Dog Program, Student Groups
 - Assemblies/Community Service Providers
 - Information resource for substance abuse prevention and related intervention services

College Planning: Senior Conferences

- Senior conferences
 - Senior conference packet is posted <u>online</u>
 - 1-on-1, counselor with senior
 - Personally-tailored post-HS planning
 - 2-year school, 4-year school, vocational, military, work
 - Topics discussed:
 - Graduation requirements/audit
 - Reinforcement from junior meeting
 - College application process
 - Detailed on next slide
 - Other potential postsecondary options

College Applications To Do List: BARNEGAT HIGH SCHOOL

College Applications: Apply RARNEGAT HIGH SCHOOL

- Applications completed via:
 - Common App
 - Common App: 1000+ schools
 - Made with personal email address
 - Direct-to-Institution, through college website
 - If school participates in Common App, BHS recommends utilizing
 Common App

commo

- Coalition
 - Similar to Common App but not as utilized

College Applications: Apply MARNEGAT HIGH SCHOOL MARNEGAT HIGH SCHOOL

- Application Essay
 - Opportunity to share personal information not reflected elsewhere
 - Authenticity is important
- Application deadlines
 - Early Decision early deadline, binding
 - Early Action early deadline
 - Regular varies by college
 - Rolling application reviewed upon receipt
- Safety vs. Target vs. Reach

College Applications: Letters of Recommendation

- Two Teachers
 - Choose teachers who can best speak to your academic ability, work ethic.
 - Consider your major and include teacher of relevant subject
- School Counselor
- Other Recommenders
 - Dependent upon circumstance, you may want to include a non-academic source (coach, boss)
 - This does not count as a teacher letter of recommendation
- Be aware of each college's requirements for letters of recommendation
- Teacher Recommendation Form / Counselor Recommendation Form
 - Available online and in Counseling Office
- FERPA complete release authorization to waive right to read letters

College Applications: Naviance Marnegat High School

- Link with Common App
 - Sign into Naviance
 - Barnegat email, password can be reset by student
 - Colleges I'm Applying To
 - Match Accounts
- Request Letters of Recommendation
 - Colleges Tab
 - Letters of Recommendation
 - Add Request
 - Select Teacher
 - General Request



College Applications: Test Scores Test Scores

Test scores to be sent directly from testing companies

- College Board (collegeboard.org or sat.org)
- ACT (act.org)
- Counselors are not involved in this
- Plan ahead
 - Takes 2-4 weeks to process

Test Optional

- Check your college admissions' websites regarding testing requirements for the class of 2024.

College Applications: Transcript Request Form

- Complete once you submit application(s)
- Available on Counseling website
 - BHS Transcript Request Form
- Alerts counselor to send official documents
- Specify method of application
- Specify letters of recommendation to send, per college's requirements
- Can submit for up to five colleges on one form
- May take up to ten days

College Applications: Financial Aid

- FAFSA: Free Application for Federal Student Aid
 - <u>fafsa.gov</u>
 - Opens in December
 - Based on 2022 income tax return information
- Additional forms
 - HESAA / NJFAMS
 - CSS Profiles
 - College-specific forms
 - Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF)

Financial Aid 101 BARNEGAT HIGH SCHOOL

Needs-based

- Driven by household income
- Determined by FAFSA
- Pending on family member #: income ratio
 - The bigger the family and/or the lower the income, the greater the funding

Merit-based

- Driven by student's academic records
- Determined by transcript and/or scores submitted
- Incorporates one or more of the following:
 - GPA
 - SAT score / ACT score
 - Athletics

Financial Aid 101 BARNEGAT HIGH SCHOOL

- Gift Money: no payback necessary
 - Grants
 - Typically need-based
 - Scholarship
 - Often merit-based
- Loan Money: payback required
 - Federal loans
 - Fixed, lower rates
 - Deferred interest accrual
 - Private loans
 - Often higher interest
 - May accrue interest as soon as loan is initiated

NJ STARS BARNEGAT HIGH SCHOOL

- Students who finish in the top 15% of the class in junior OR senior year are eligible.
- Covers the cost of tuition only for up to 5 semesters at community college
- NJ STARS does not cover remedial courses
 - Remedial courses must be completed before NJ STARS tuition will be paid (1 year to complete remedial work).
- Must take 12-18 college credits a semester and maintain GPA

* Funding is dependent upon annual state appropriations

Scholarships BARNEGAT HIGH SCHOOL

- BHS Local Scholarships
 - Involves Barnegat community and related organizations
 - Assembly for all seniors prior to scholarship release
 - Instructions and application will be made available online at that time
 - Scholarship Night held annually in May
