Creature Creation Project

The "Creature Creation Collaboration" project was inspired by the international "Monster Project" where working artists reimagine artworks sent in by children across the world. The project aims to encourage childhood creativity and show children that their ideas matter and are inspiring. Prompted by questions from the High School art students, our 5th-grade students (instructed by Ms. Maria Altomare) created "creatures" from their imagination. Students also composed a descriptive paragraph, detailing specifics, such as the creature's characteristics, personality, and environment. Once completed, the 5th graders sent their work over to BHS to be transformed by advanced ceramic and drawing students (instructed by Mrs. Astin Williams and Ms. Nina Polcino). High School students used the elementary drawings and the literary pieces as inspiration for their interpretation of the assignment in both two and three-dimensional forms. From there, students in the Recording Arts classes (instructed by Mr. Samuel Salguero) analyzed the artwork and written pieces and used that to compose original soundtracks to each drawing/sculpture, turning the visual experience into an auditory one as well.
