Preparations for this massive undertaking begin in September and continue throughout December. This would not be possible without the generosity of our caring and compassionate staff and community.

Gifts for the holidays were provided to 126 families, including 367 children, through the generous donations of our local community. We would also like to express our heartfelt gratitude to everyone who contributed to help brighten the holidays and show our Barnegat families the true spirit of the season!

- District schools held Jeans Day fundraisers to support our families in need. 61 families were adopted between the six schools.
- The Barnegat PBA 296 held its Annual Toy Drive. Officers collected toys from local businesses and Elfie's House. Toys were delivered and sorted for distribution to the individual schools. Monetary donations were also provided by the officers to fund additional items for our students. Elfie's House also donated \$450 in gift cards to provide food for our families.
- A staff member donated \$100 to support our families.

- The Barnegat Transportation Department adopted a family to provide gifts for the holiday.
- The BHS Environmental Club donated \$800 to provide gifts to our families in need.
- Nine children ages 8-13 years old participated in "Shop with a Cop" at Walmart in Little Egg Harbor. Barnegat Police officers were on hand to assist the children while they shopped.
- The Wright Presbyterian Church of Barnegat donated \$750 to support our families in need.
